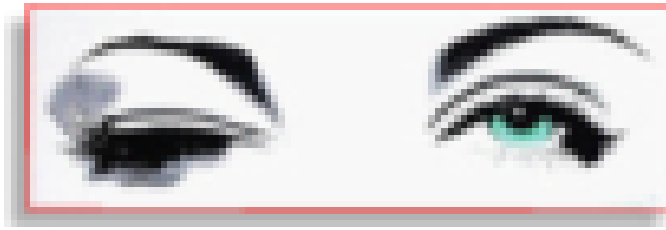


VALENTINE *LOOK OUT*
